

Follow the step-by-step instructions below to learn how to **easily whitelist**FEN emails on all major email providers.

## **Gmail Instructions**

### Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open Gmail and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Open the email.
- 4. Click on the sender's name or email address.
- 5. Click "Add to Contacts".

## Method 2: Create a Filter

- 1. Click on the gear icon in the top right corner and select "See all settings".
- 2. Go to the "Filters and Blocked Addresses" tab.
- 3. Click "Create a new filter".
- 4. In the "From" field, enter the email address or domain you want to whitelist.
- 5. Click "Create filter".
- 6. Check "Never send it to Spam".
- 7. Click "Create filter".

# **Outlook Instructions**

# Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open Outlook and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Right-click the email.
- 4. Select "Add to Outlook Contacts".

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### Method 2: Add to Safe Senders List

- 1. Click on the gear icon in the top right corner and select "View all Outlook settings".
- 2. Go to "Mail" > "Junk email".
- 3. Under "Safe senders and domains", add the sender's email address or domain.
- 4. Click "Save".

## **Yahoo Mail Instructions**

### Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open Yahoo Mail and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Open the email.
- 4. Click on the three horizontal dots (More options) in the top right corner of the email.
- 5. Select "Add Sender to Contacts".

### Method 2: Create a Filter

- 1. Click on "Mail" > "Filters".
- 2. Click "Add".
- 3. Enter a name for the filter.
- 4. In the "From" field, enter the email address or domain.
- 5. Choose "Inbox" or another folder as the destination.
- 6. Click "Save".

## **AOL Mail Instructions**

#### Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open AOL Mail and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Open the email.
- 4. Click on the sender's name or email address.
- 5. Click "Add to Contacts".

### Method 2: Safe List

- 1. Click on "Options" (gear icon) and select "Mail Settings".
- 2. Go to the "Spam Settings" tab.
- 3. Under "Safe List", add the sender's email address.
- 4. Click "Save".

# **Apple Mail Instructions**

### Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open Apple Mail and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Open the email.
- 4. Click on the sender's email address in the message header.
- 5. Click "Add to Contacts".

### Method 2: Rules

- 1. Open Apple Mail and log in.
- 2. Click "Mail" > "Preferences".
- 3. Go to the "Rules" tab.
- 4. Click "Add Rule".
- 5. Set criteria to match emails from the sender's address.
- 6. In the "Perform the following actions" section, choose "Move Message" to "Inbox".
- 7. Click "OK".

## **Windows Live Mail Instructions**

### Method 1: Add to Contacts

- 1. Open Windows Live Mail and log in.
- 2. Find an email from the sender you want to whitelist.
- 3. Right-click the email.
- 4. Select "Add to Contacts".
- 5. Confirm by clicking "Add".

#### Method 2: Safe List

- 1. Click "Home" > "Junk" > "Junk E-mail Options".
- 2. Go to the "Safe Senders" tab.
- 3. Click "Add".
- 4. Enter the email address or domain and click "Add".
- 5. Click "OK".
